2. First Hui of the New Trust

Nominations for Chair , Treasurer and Secretary required

Annie was nominated for Chair – Unanimous

John Chand nominated for Secretary – Unanimous

It was put to the Trust by Annie that because we now have internet banking – she could print off the bank statements and attach any invoices that have been paid to match the statement . It is the truest form of the finances – and can be done without to much hassle .

Trustees agree – and are all ok with this .

Annie to send in all the paperwork to the Maori Land Court .

3. Financial Report - Annie

All bank statements and invoices paid are provided to the Trustees – from October 2022 – to February 2023.

Will also have to get the accountants do to the Financial Summary for the 2022 -2023 at the end of March \cdot

INCOMING: Have received \$1000 in koha from whanau who have used the Marae over the holiday period.

Our Savings account makes about \$6k a year plus if it remains untouched . (Approx \$500 per month)

OUTGOING: Getting the drive to the urupa and carpark cleaned up was our biggest expense – plus our

Annual insurance of just over \$6k.

Since getting the solar panels in just before xmas – our latest power bill was \$2.00. We are expecting this to eventually be zero. Massive thank you to the Ngatiwai Trustboard for having these installed at no cost to the marae.

4. MAINTENANCE

Annie: We are part of the MIP (Marae Infrastructure Program) with the council. They will come out here in June / July this year and go over all the things that need doing eg Kitchen, toilets etc. This is not funding we have to apply for – it is a 10 year program that started in 2015. They will assess what needs doing – and do it. Our Kaikokiri (Maori Key Advisor) said its worth waiting for and that it has already made massive changes to other marae they have worked with.

Trust has agreed to get mattress room done asap . Sammy to follow up with original quote . And also a new playground for our tamariki .

We are registered for the clean water solutions also with council – which hopefully will end with us getting good clean water from the tap to drink.

Need to also get water set up properly at the Urupa . Sammy to look into that .

Aunty myra has also requested we get a general waste bin . Annie to organise .

We currently do not have an operating committee – however Kahui has stayed on to just help out with the Lawn mowing Roster and any contacts in regards to any maintenance needed.

Any whanau who cant for some reason do the lawns - please just let us know so we can sort out .

5. THE CHARTER

Is now complete. Annie to photo copy and keep a copy in the Whare kai.

6. SAND DREDGING

MBL have appealed all the decisions re the sand mining and it is now in the environment court . Long drawn out process — and in the meantime they are still allowed to dredge until its sorted . MBL did reach out to me — wanting to meet with us with some ideas on mitigating the effects of the mining — but I advised that we want the mining stopped . There is no middle ground on this issue .

7. DOME VALLEY TIP

The Ngati Manuhiri Settlement Trust has done an about turn and now support the Tip . This is disappointing . There has been no engagement with us as Ahi kaa , Maha whenua , hapu or as beneficiaries of that Trust . This is unacceptable .

Annie: We have supported this issue with the Tip right from the start – until now. The fact that the NMST have not even engaged with the hapu, beneficiaries, with anyone is not right.

NMST represents our Tupuna whanau from this marae. We do not want a tip in our back yard. Near the Hoteo Awa where it could potentially leak into the kaipara Harbour. This is not what we want for our whanaunga in the Kaipara. This is not the history we want to create for our tamariki. our mokopuna.

Motion: For Annie to provide a statement of evidence on behalf of the Marae, Hapu, whanau in support of Stop the Tip and The Ngati Whatua Runanga.

8. GENERAL BUSINESS

Trust have agreed to have 4 hui a year as per the charter. Every quarter. If there is any urgent business that requires a kanohi ki te kanohi hui – then we can organise that when the need arises.

At the moment we are still only taking whanau bookings. We need to have the marae up to scratch re health and safety, Fire Safety, safe drinking water etc before we can hire to outside groups. We need to start working on achieving this as soon as possible. Perhaps inline with the MIP that is going to be happening here.

Also - In light of the severe weather events the the Ngatiwai Trust Board has purchased generators for each of their Marae . We will need to collect our one and think about a safe place to keep it .

For now Aunty Myra keeps track of all the Marae bookings . Will look into a more streamlined system to use once the marae is compliant .
