

This flag was created for the Marae trustees in the early 2000s. It was accepted by the people and kaumatua at a Hui a iwi. The design follows our pepeha as follows

- The fish design top and bottom indicate the fish Pakirikiri in our awa which also gives name to the area known as Pakiri- its ingoa tuturu being Pakirikiri
- The two maunga- Tamaahua (Green) and Nanakia (Black) on Hauturu-o-Toi are our Maunga. The highest point is called Puke-o-Nanakia after the Patu Paiarehe chief Nanakia.
- Within our Pepeha is the phrase Ko Hauturu Te Moutere Koingo- The Island yearned for.
- The sea waves indicate our inner sea which is Tikapa Te Moana
